 - ii. Marcia Kappa Anderson informed the members and board that the committee is almost out of the gift of the trivets
 - iii. 22 made a motion to approve \$100 for 10 trivets for welcoming committee
 - iv. 32 seconded motion
 - v. Motion carries
 - b. Property committee
 - i. Nat has laminated copy of map of properties
 - ii. No other updates
 - c. Garden committee
 - i. Katharine Kinderman did weeding and mulched by the Maple Beach sign in the park
 - ii. Katharine Kinderman asked if anyone wants to meet after the meeting to discuss rotating who is going to pull weeds
 - d. Heritage committee
 - i. Michelle La Pean Usher informed the members she has no updates
 - ii. It was asked what this committee is for

- 1. Michelle La Pean Usher explained that she wanted to find out more about the history of MBPH
- 2. Put together old photos
- iii. Requested the board to send an email asking if anyone has any old information they would like to share
- e. Community events planning committee
 - i. The committee has had a few informal meetings
 - ii. The committee has decided to have a block party/carnival on Elm street
 - 1. Wants everyone to bring a dish to pass
 - 2. Wants everyone to bring drinks and eating utensils
 - 3. Jim and Andrea Belanger volunteered to set up a volleyball net in their yard
 - 4. Games
 - a. Been bags and ladder toss
 - b. 3 legged race
 - c. Spook and egg race
 - d. Pass the balloon
 - 5. The committee would like to ask Nancy Planter to do face painting for the kids
 - 6. Shooting for July 28th as the day of the block party/carnival
 - iii. Nat met with guys from Mallwood during trash clean up and they didn't want anything to do with a kickball tournament
 - iv. The trash day was discussed further
 - 1. Not many Maple Beach members were involved
 - 2. Mallwood paid for all garbage bags and food for cook out
 - v. A member asked if we are doing anything for Mallwood for letting us use their clubhouse
 - 1. Sent thank you card for letting from last meeting

7. Unfinished business

- a. Beach in park
 - i. Jim Belanger would donate first load of sand
 - ii. A member informed everyone that this has been brought up for many years and it has never happened as the sand will wash away when there are high waters
 - iii. Jeff Lowry informed the members that the DNR has restrictions
 - 1. Put down barrier to maintain foliage
 - 2. DNR only allows pee gravel
 - 3. Plant trees for shoreline
 - 4. Limited by what DNR allows
 - iv. Members have had conversations with Mallwood's members
 - 1. Mallwood paid roughly \$30k for beach area
 - v. Tom Nolfi read an email from Andrew Baker
 - 1. Flood plain use to be controlled by the DNR
 - 2. See attached document
 - vi. An option would be to move rocks and make layer to prevent erosion
 - vii. Topic is closed-not moving forward with it
- b. Parking spots in park
 - i. Brad M. said MBPH owns it. Joe Rossi said we do not have that in writing
 - ii. Keith Anderson said he spoke with Andrew Baker who said that it is MBPH
 - iii. We need to look into this
 - iv. Joe Rossi says it should be a deeded piece of property
 - v. Keith Anderson will look into this

- vi. Jeff Huberd asked why we don't just donate the road to the county
 - 1. Explained to Jeff that we need to figure who owns it before we can do anything
 - 2. Jeff Huberd lives on 11523 N Maple Drive and said that the road was donated and was blacktopped
- vii. Kay O'Connel said that it has been a private road
 - 1. Has been to the town board 3-4 times
 - 2. The town does not want the road
 - 3. No taxes are paid on it
- viii. Jeff Lowry reported information from 2005
 - 1. The county didn't want the cost of paving the road
 - 2. Other concerns
 - 3. Jeff Lowry stated that some people on the road don't want it paved
 - 4. Jeff Lowry says it is considered MBPH property
 - 5. No control over erosion-water is being re-directed into his property
 - 6. Debi said she would personally vote to hand it over to the town of Milton
 - 7. Tom Nolfi read another email from Andrew Baker
 - a. Road is dedicated to public-town of Milton the county owns
- c. Swing set in park
 - i. Laverne Luschinger and Eric Schmeling fixed the swing set
 - 1. LaVerne added cement around the poles that were not stable
 - 2. Eric Schmeling fixed the bolts
 - ii. Brad M. brought up that people walk away from park when they're on the swing set
 - 1. No one has reported any concerns to the board
 - 2. Topic closed
- d. Reading of letter from lawyer
 - i. Nat Ross read letter from lawyer
 - 1. Currently in litigation
 - ii. Brad M. asked if members should be worried
 - 1. Nat Ross mentioned that if the association is dissolved, someone will buy the park and do with it as they please
- e. Trees in park
 - i. Ray Harris has not been payed completely
 - ii. Contact Ray to finish cutting down stump
 - iii. Brad M. has been the contact in coordination with Ray Harris

8. New business

- a. Mowing of park
 - i. It was informed that the mowing of the park was out for bids
 - ii. Brad M. mowed the park last year for \$80 per mow
 - 1. Used MBPH lawn mower
 - iii. Local company bid \$58 per mow
 - 1. Will use own equipment
 - 2. Has insurance-no liability
 - iv. Brad M put in a bid for \$50
 - 1. Did not submit insurance verification
 - 2. Jeanine M said they were trying to get insurance but the board didn't give them enough time
 - 3. Informed Brad M. and Jeanine M. that park needed to be mowed and couldn't wait any longer
 - 4. MBPH also had to pay \$75 to CPA to have an I9 sent to Brad M.

- v. The board and members will re-discuss every year
- vi. Some members said he isn't mowing the entire park-including behind members homes
 - 1. Told the members that he may need direction in where to mow
 - 2. There are soggy areas that will not be mowed until they dry up
- b. Jeff Lowry asked to discuss roads that have now been vacated
 - i. 5 roads have now been vacated.
 - ii. Jeff Lowry requested easement between himself and Kay O'Connel to be vacated in 2006 and was denied by Kay
 - iii. Access to park has been primarily on lot line.
 - iv. Jeff has not infringed on property but has maintained it.
 - v. Putting foundation of pole barn at risk.
 - vi. Was excavated-didn't see in meeting minutes that it was discussed. The excavating was done by Tom Nolfi and was not approved by the association and has caused damage to Jeff's property.
 - vii. Scraper came in on tracker and changed direction of water.
 - viii. Asking if board would take a vote and vacate that easement.
 - ix. Per Kay, she has not consumed any property
 - x. Jeff wants to vacate (split in half) and Kay doesn't
- c. Leave this as open business
- d. Key Oconnel asked permission to put a drainage tile on both sides of her house (one on easement and one in park)
 - i. Informed Kay that the board needs direction in writing
- e. Marcia Kapa Anderson asked if coffee and doughnuts could be brought to meetings
 - i. 22-Marcia motioned to approve bring coffee and doughnuts to general member meetings
 - ii. LaVerne seconded motion
 - iii. Motion carries
- f. Kay O'Connel shared that Rock County's Clean Sweep is coming up and wanted to share that with everyone
 - i. See attached document

9. Elections

- a. Laverne used map to show the different districts and how each district should have a representative on the board
- b. 3 positions open-(Joe Rossi-Sgt of Arms, Laverne Luschinger-Director, and Katharine Kinderman-Director)
 - i. Members running are Laverne Luschinger, Joe Rossi, and Keith Anderson
 - ii. Laverne: 32 votes
 - iii. Keith: 40 votes
 - iv. Ioe: 38 votes
 - v. All 3 members were majority voted on the board
